# STATUE OF LIBERTY MAZE SOLUTION

**Start at the base and head to the torch**

The cornerstone of the pedestal upon which the Statue of Liberty stands on Bedloe's Island in New York Harbor was laid on August 5, 1884.

Although the statue itself was designed by French sculptor Frédéric Bartholdi, the iron framework that supports the statue was designed by designer and builder Alexandre-Gustave Eiffel, renowned for the Eiffel Tower in Paris.

Liberty's pedestal was constructed within Fort Wood, a star-shaped fortification that was constructed between 1808 and 1811 to defend the entrance to New York Harbor.

Although it weighs about 100 tons, the copper skin of the statue is a little thinner than two pennies held together.

The red line here shows one of several solutions to the maze.
