The spaces between the names have been added for you.

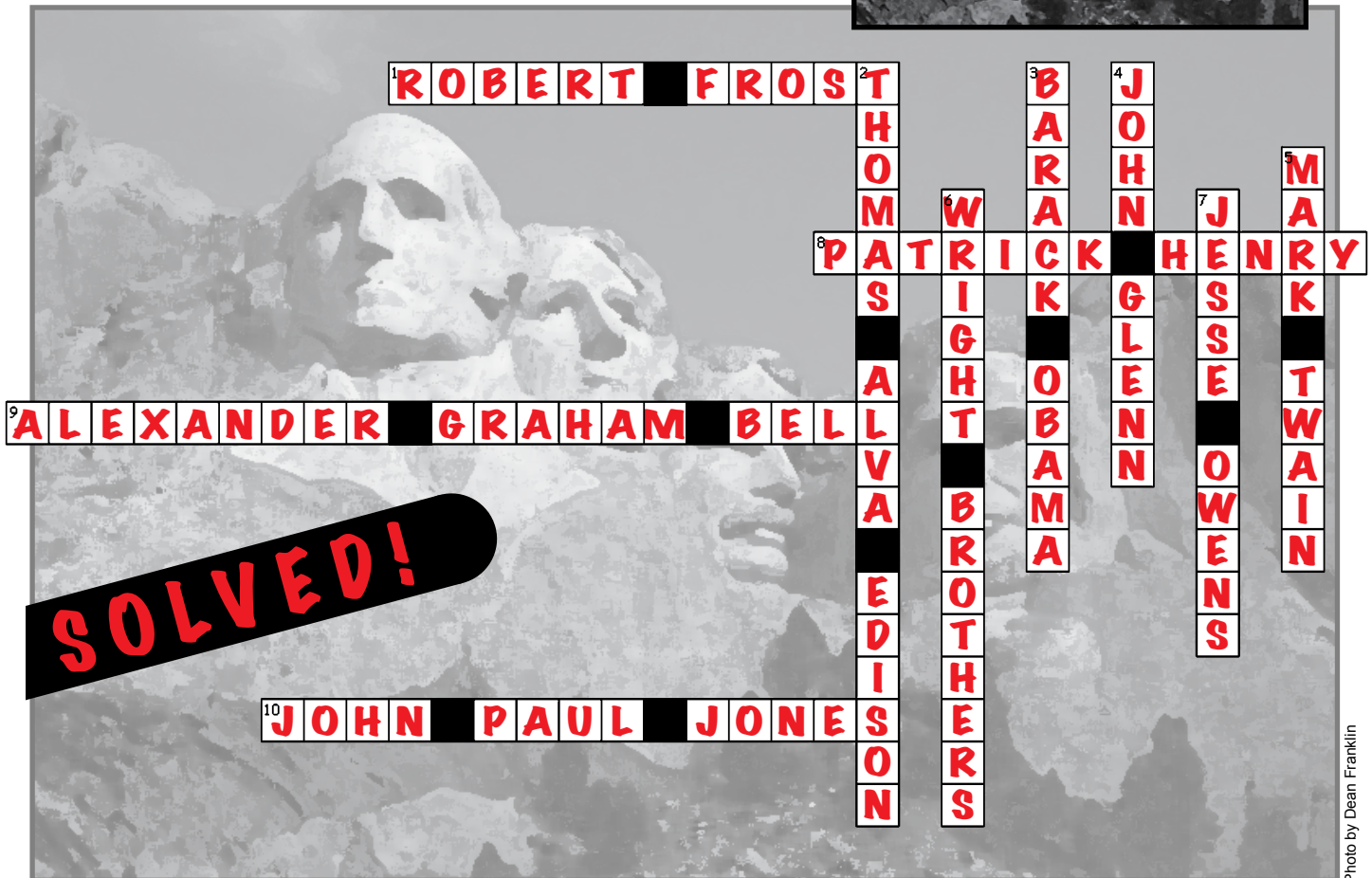
