THE WORDS OF JULIA CHILD (THE FRENCH CHEF)



Julia Child, born McWilliams (August 15, 1912 – August 13, 2004) was a chef and author. She is credited for introducing French cooking to American kitchens. She majored in English, and enjoyed playing sports. During World War II, she was a top secret researcher for the Office of Strategic Services and assisted developers of shark repellent to keep sharks from exploding ordnance aimed at German U-boats. She spent time in both Sri Lanka and China. Julia McWilliams married Paul Cushing Child, a poet and artist who had lived in Paris. He introduced his wife to French cuisine. Julia was inspired to begin her study at Le Cordon Bleu. She wrote books to teach Americans how to cook in the French style. Julia Child—The French Chef—became a well known TV personality and expert on French cuisine.

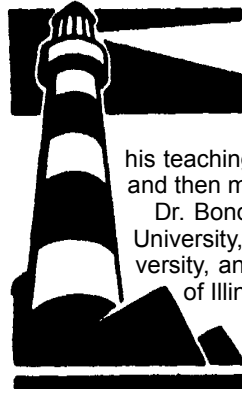
